In this context, we confirm the following:

- For the purpose of the audit, we have obtained all the information and explanations, which to the best of our knowledge and belief, were necessary. In our opinion, the Placement Report complies with the Indian Placement Reporting Standards Revision 2.2.
- The validation of information presented in the report is based on communication received by IIM-A from recruiting companies. Brickwork Ratings (BWR) has not independently sourced any information or documentation.
- 3. We have verified the information with respect to job location, function and remuneration presented in the report with communication received from recruiters. The information has been categorised as best as possible under different salary heads as given in the IPRS Revision 2.2; where a break-up was not available, the salary has been considered only as 'Maximum Earning Potential'.
- 4. Stock Options have been mentioned for two students without details on how much vests in the first year. The amount relating to stock options has not been considered for calculation of 'Maximum Earning Potential'.
- The acceptance of offers and the number of students opting out of the placement process has been established through written communication from those students.
- We have only audited the salary figures in the placement report and not the report's overview section, which explains the placement process.

Overview

The final placement process for the Batch of 2017-19 of the Post Graduate Programme in Food and Agribusiness Management (PGP-FABM) at IIM Ahmedabad was successfully completed on 11th February 2019. 43 students out of 45 from the batch of 2017-19 were presented with job opportunities in food, agribusiness, and allied sectors, further corroborating the quality of students and the pertinence of this specialized Programme to the Food and Agribusiness sector.

Placement Process

The Placement Process was conducted in two stages. The first was the Laterals process, where firms interviewed students with prior work experience and offered them mid-level managerial positions. The second stage was the Final Placement process, where firms were grouped into cohorts based on the profile offered, and groups of cohorts were invited to campus across different clusters.

Top Recruiters

A total of 27 firms took part in the process from varying sectors like FMCG, Agri Inputs and Services, Food Processing and Supply Chain, Food and Agribusiness PE-VC, Food and Agri Consulting, Agri Commodity Trading, e-commerce, and retail. Total of 51 offers were extended to the students. Firms such as Godrej Agrovet, PI Industries, Jain Irrigation, Pioneering Ventures, Ninjacart and Waycool extended 3 offers each. The process welcomed first time-recruiters like Ernst and Young (EY), RBL Bank, and Reliance Foundation. Regular recruiters like ADM, Pioneering Ventures, Reckitt Benckiser, Cloudtail, and General Mills reaffirmed their confidence in the Program and Placement process by extending multiple offers.

The batch attracted a diverse pool of recruiters, ranging from MNCs as well as upcoming start-up firms in the agri-business domain like Agrostar, Gramophone and Our Foods. The students explored opportunities across multiple roles in Finance, Sales and Marketing, Supply Chain, Operations, Commodity Trading, Project Management, and Consulting.

The process, with the continuation of "Dream Application", helped students choose sectors and roles that best fit their career aspirations.

Social Sector

One student from the batch opted to work for a nonprofit foundation for a conglomerate.

This shows the inclination of students to work in the social and development sector.

Description of Salary Heads

- a) Fixed Yearly Cash Component: This is a total of the annual basic salary and additional guaranteed cash components. These additional components include cash payments and allowances that are part of the annual package. The term guaranteed signifies that the amount is certain unless there is an overall pay revision. The components falling under this salary head are final and are not related to performance.
- b) One-time cash Payment: This head indicates the value of the remuneration given to a candidate as one-time cash benefit mostly at the time of joining.
- c) Total guaranteed Cash Component: This is the sum of fixed yearly cash component and one-time cash payment.
- d) Maximum Earning Potential: This is the sum of total guaranteed cash component, maximum possible-linked variable pays, and all other components of salary that are a part of the offer. This can include long term compensation such as PF, gratuity, and other perks as well.
