#### Overview

The PGP-FABM (Post-Graduate Programme in Food & Agribusiness Management) summer placement process for the batch of 2022-24 was completed successfully on 4th November 2022. The process was carried out in a hybrid mode. 47 students of this batch did summer internship in the months of April-June 2023. The successful completion of the placement process within a day is a testament to the institute's high-quality learning experience and the robust placement process that provides adequate flexibility to both recruiters and students.

The FABM students looking for summer placements were well-received by the industry and 30 companies participated in the placement process. The placements witnessed a balance of roles from all the sectors like Agri input, BFSI, Consulting, Consumer goods (FMCG), Food Processing, and other sectors.

The placement process witnessed regular recruiters who reaffirmed their confidence in the program such as Godrej Agrovet Limited (GAVL), Reckitt Benckiser, Nestle, PepsiCo, Zepto and Yes Bank. 
