Overview

The PGP-FABM (Post-Graduate Programme in Food & Agribusiness Management) summer placement process for the batch of 2023-25 was completed successfully on 3rd November 2023. The process was carried out in a hybrid mode. 45 students of FABM Class of 2023-25 did their summer internship in the months of April-June 2024. The successful completion of the placement process within a day is a testament to the institute's high-quality learning experience and the robust placement process that provides adequate flexibility to both recruiters and students.

The FABM students looking for summer placements were well-received by the industry and 43 companies participated in the placement process. The placements witnessed a balance of roles from all the sectors like Agri input, BFSI, Consulting, Consumer goods (FMCG), Food Processing, and other sectors.

The placement process witnessed regular recruiters who reaffirmed their confidence in the program such as Accenture, Ernst & Young (EY), Marico, Godrej Agrovet, Bayer India, UPL, Nestle, PepsiCo, Olam Agri, DeHaat, International Flavors & Fragrances (IFF), PI Industries, Many new recruiters also showed a keen interest in the batch, which is visible by the participation of industry giants like Storia Foods, ReNew, Environmental Defense Fund (EDF), Beaphar, Louis Dreyfus Company (LDC) among others. The program also witnessed participation of firms from Conglomerates like DCM Shriram, RPG Group (Harrison's Malayalam), Murugappa Group (Coromandel International) and Export Trading Group (ETG).
